# **Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Enrollment**

If you have not already registered for electronic funds transfer (EFT) payments, we have simplified the process with the addition of a downloadable registration form. You can find the form on the <u>Claims and Billing Page of our website</u> under EFT along with a step-by-step guide. EFT offers a fast and easy way to receive your payments. There are **no fees** for single payer agreements to receive a direct payment from AmeriHealth Caritas North Carolina via EFT or to receive an electronic remittance advice (ERA). Payments are administered by Change Healthcare and ECHO® Health Inc.

#### **PHARMACY**

### **Pharmacy Prior Authorizations**

Prior authorization is required for certain drugs prescribed to AmeriHealth Caritas North Carolina members. Our Pharmacy team reviews pharmacy prior authorizations to make sure your prescribed medications are safe and appropriate.

- You can find drug and indication-specific pharmacy prior authorization forms for download on our website here. Please fax completed forms to **1-877-234-4274**.
- It will save you time and effort if you use the drug or indication-specific pharmacy prior authorization forms when submitting requests for your patients. Submitting prior authorization requests for a drug on the Standard Drug Request Form may result in a denials and delays in treatment for your patients due to missing pertinent information.
  - Example: There is a higher rate of denials for opioid prior authorizations when submitted on the Standard Form. Instead, utilize the Short-Acting and Long-Acting
     Opioid Analgesics Forms and be sure to submit clinical documentation as instructed to support your request.

**Remember:** In the event a member needs to begin therapy with a medication before you can obtain prior authorization, pharmacies are authorized to dispense up to a 72-hour emergency supply.

 Providers also can initiate pharmacy prior authorizations electronically via electronic prior authorization through your EHR vendor, in our provider portal, <u>NaviNet</u>, or by calling 1-866-885-1406, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday through Saturday.

# Physician's Drug Program (PDP) Reminders

AmeriHealth Caritas North Carolina follows NC Medicaid's Clinical Coverage Policy No: 1B, <a href="Physician's Drug Program">Physician's Drug Program</a> that outlines coverage for drugs purchased for use in an outpatient office setting when the administering provider is also the purchasing provider of the drug Drugs administered under the Physician's Drug Program do not require a clinical prior authorization, except when otherwise stated. Please use the link below to access the details on coverage in the (PDP).

Examples of covered drugs include:

- Injectable drugs
- IV administrations
- Chemotherapy
- Vaccines/toxoids
- Immune globulins
- Radiopharmaceuticals
- Long Acting Reproductive Contraceptives

Note: While these claims do not require clinical review, they could be flagged for review based on cost or diagnosis.



### **COVID-19 Vaccination Incentive**

COVID-19 vaccines are the best way to prevent serious illness, hospitalization and death from the disease. AmeriHealth Caritas North Carolina continues to promote full vaccination among our members, including an incentive program that offers members a financial reward on their ACNC CARE Card for getting vaccinated. Beginning this month, our incentive program offers any member that was not vaccinated before November 1, 2021 the opportunity to earn a reward. The CARE Card may be used to purchase over-the-counter health medicines, health products and supplies, and healthy foods at a variety of retailers, including WalMart, Walgreens, CVS, Food Lion, and Dollar General.
